# Fire Chief's Report to Board of Commissioners December 19, 2024

#### • Customer Service (emergent and non-emergent):

• 50 Calls for service from SW First Responders since your last meeting.

## • Apparatus/Fleet:

- 1. Engine 32: Two minor warranty items addressed and repaired by the mechanic. Position sensor on the deck gun and foam cell leaking.
- 2. SCBA Bottle Hydrotesting: All KCFD3 bottles are now complete with hydrotesting. Two RIT bottles from Station 30 were completed as well.
- 3. Surplus engine has been listed with Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus for 30 days. Price lowered to \$85K. Will hold on to that price until after the new year passes.
- 4. Will be purchasing oil and filters for 2025 annual service this year when NAPA has their 50% off sale.
- 5. Water tenders chained up for the season.
- 6. Station 33 water tank drained
- 7. Station 32 water tank insulation placed around the valves.

# • Other items:

- 1. Shaded Fuel Project: Contacted DNR early December and advised them that the area along SR 14, was not completed adequately. DNR will discuss it with the contractor.
- 2. 2025 Winter Firefighter Academy is ready to go. The beginning date is January 28, 2025. I'll be teaching three courses and involved in testing. WKRFA will have six personnel enrolled.
- 3. Working on WKRFA/City of White Salmon interlocal agreement for service / water use. 12/16/24 PENDING City Council review.
- 4. EMT training is being offered through Columbia River Gorge Community College. WKRFA has four people who need EMT training. One person is seeking a bridge course from Registered Nurse to EMTB. Tom Crumpacker is coordinating with myself. UPDATE: Looking for scholarship opportunities. SWFR personnel enrolled into the community college program.
- 5. Reviewing end-of-year budget status. Scheduled a few projects with our mechanic for mid-December to allow for invoicing to land in January. (radios, Engine 34 inspections/maintenance etc.)
- 6. Monitoring regional propane prices. Carson's competing vendor reached out to us. Currently, they are both at the same price per gallon.
- 7. Plan to coordinate with Chief Hunsaker for end-of-year actions for transition to WKRFA.
- 8. Leased copy machine exchange complete.
- 9. I attended the KCIFA meeting in Goldendale.
- 10. I attended SE Region IMT 2024 fire season after action review in Ellensburg.
